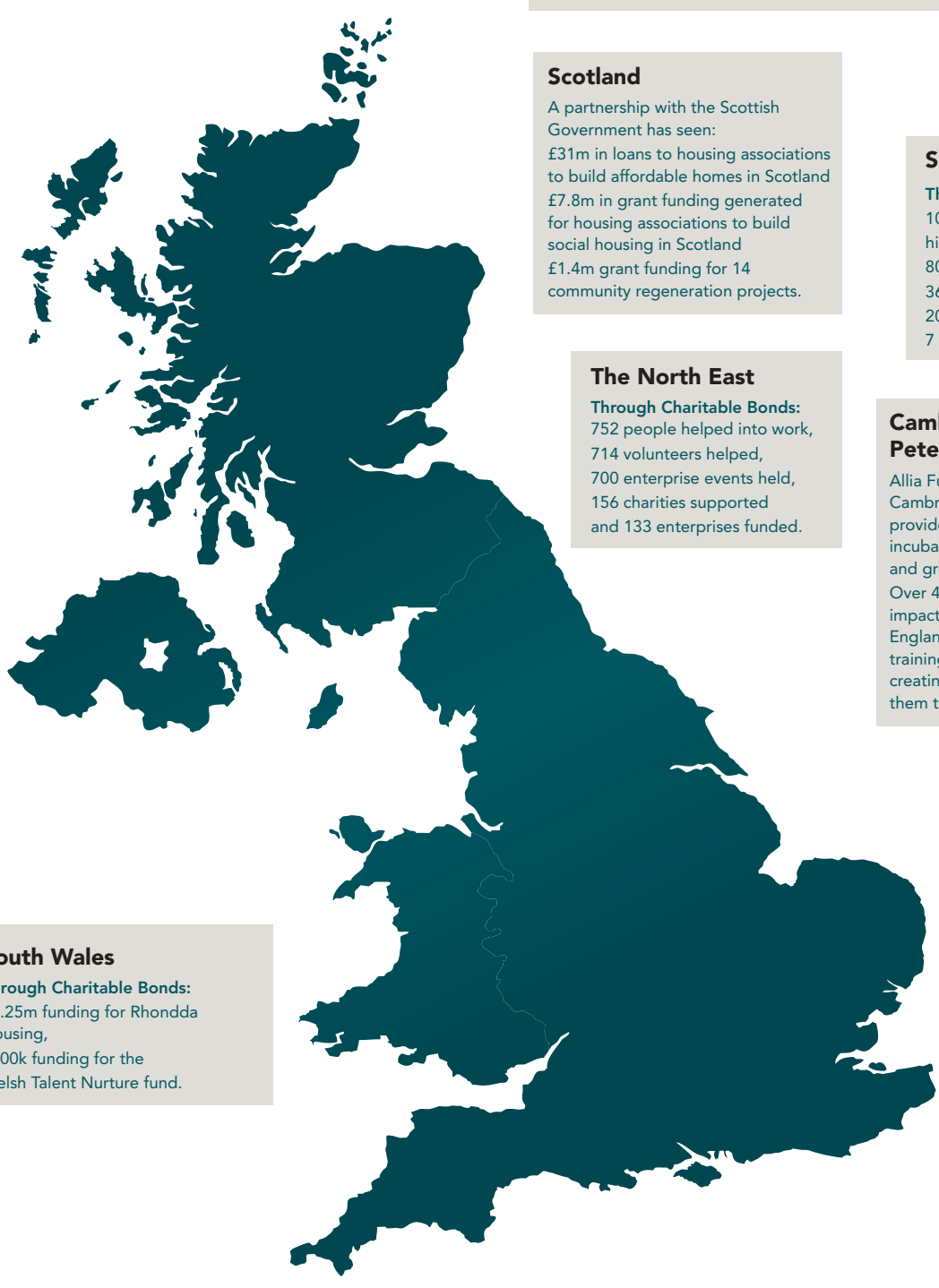


Take a look at what we have done over the years around the UK to tackle these problems.



## NATIONWIDE

£58m has been raised with bonds listed on London Stock Exchange, using Allia's new Retail Charity Bonds platform.

### Scotland

A partnership with the Scottish Government has seen:  
£31m in loans to housing associations to build affordable homes in Scotland  
£7.8m in grant funding generated for housing associations to build social housing in Scotland  
£1.4m grant funding for 14 community regeneration projects.

### South Yorkshire

**Through Charitable Bonds:**  
1000 personal loans to replace high interest lending,  
800 people helped into work,  
36 micro-business start-ups  
20 voluntary sector jobs and  
7 social enterprise growth loans.

### The North East

**Through Charitable Bonds:**  
752 people helped into work,  
714 volunteers helped,  
700 enterprise events held,  
156 charities supported  
and 133 enterprises funded.

### Cambridge and Peterborough

Allia Future Business Centres in Cambridge and Peterborough provide affordable workspace, incubation and acceleration for new and growing impact ventures.  
Over 400 social and environmental impact ventures across East of England supported with bespoke, training, mentoring and guidance creating 240 jobs and supporting them to raise £20m of investment.

### South Wales

**Through Charitable Bonds:**  
£0.25m funding for Rhondda Housing,  
£100k funding for the Welsh Talent Nurture fund.

### London

Two East London Bonds  
The first: 400 people helped into work  
Securing a derelict brown field site which provides 32 affordable rented homes and workspace for small and medium sized enterprises.  
The second provided grant funding to two charitable organisations, Bromley By Bow Centre and Community Links in Newham enabling young local people to develop skills and helping hundreds into work.
