Golden Lane Housing (Mencap) raises £11m for housing for people with learning disabilities

12. Retail Charity Bonds
Hightown Housing Association raises £27m for affordable housing and support

13. Retail Charity Bonds
CAF (Charities Aid Foundation) raises £26m

Greensleeves raises £30m for care and housing for older people and Dolphin Living raises £25m for more affordable homes in London



1. Citylife is conceived by Relationships Foundation
The Employment Bond concept is tested

2. We launch as Citylife
A charity, encouraging people to use their resources for social benefit. We raise £800k in our first charitable bond to tackle unemployment in Sheffield

3. More charitable bonds
We raise £17.5m between 2001 and 2010 in charitable bonds around the UK

6. We buy a site in Cambridge
To build a Future Business centre

★ **£17.5m in bonds.** Thousands helped back to work
Grants support charities and projects which help thousands of people into work and out of debt 

7. We open Future Business Centre in Cambridge
offering affordable workspace, business support and incubation to people and organisations that want to make an impact on society

8. Social Incubator East launches
an incubation programme for social ventures. In 2016 becomes part of Cambridge Judge Business School

14. We open Future Business Centre in Peterborough

15. Serious Impact launches
a free support programme for entrepreneurs and ventures that seek to make a positive impact on people, planet or place.

16. Innovation Lab opens
as part of the Serious Impact programme

17. Future Business Centre opens in East London
Serious Impact starts supporting businesses in East London

★ **680+** ventures helped to start-up and grow
Future Business Centres: More than 680 ventures supported to start and grow. Cambridge and Peterborough at near 100% occupancy
